for Lifetime Achievement in Clinical Pharmacology

This prize will be awarded for significant achievement, both for the benefit of science and also for the benefit and health of the specialty and society in general, over a whole working life.

The winner will be chosen by the EACPT Council. Nominations should be sent by a National Society representative. In addition, nominations sent by other individuals can also be acceptable, whenever these nominations are accompanied by a letter of nomination signed by a valid representative of the National Society of the nominated candidate.

Nominations with relevant CV and list of publications and supporting statements should be sent to the EACPT secretary (jsaez@clinic.cat) by 12 midday CET on April 1st, 2025.

Supporting information and requirements

2024 EACPT Lifetime Achievement Award in Clinical Pharmacology

Candidates must:

1. Be able to demonstrate a long-standing personal contribution in any scientific, clinical, or educational field of clinical pharmacology that contributes towards the significant development of the discipline. Also, contributions in the regulatory or industry field can be taken into account.
2. Not be current members of the EACPT Executive Committee in order to be considered eligible for nomination.
3. Not be previous EACPT Lifetime Award winners. Previously nominated candidates are eligible for re-nomination. Nominations must be resubmitted at the time of each new call.
4. Have accepted the nomination.

Application documents

1. Candidates must be nominated using a signed nomination letter. This nomination letter should be signed by a valid representative of the National Society. Supporting information (i.e. CV of the candidate) should also be supplied. The letter must state that the candidate accepts the nomination.
2. The list of publications and supporting statements must be submitted electronically accompanying the nomination letter.
3. Completed and signed nomination letter, together with any supporting information, must be sent to the Secretary of EACPT (jsaez@clinic.cat), by the notified closing date: 12 midday CET on April 1st, 2025.

The successful candidate

The Award will be presented at the EACPT Congress in Helsinki, June 28th- July 1st, 2025.

The Award winner will be expected to give an Award Lecture at the Congress, which will be recorded for posting on the EACPT website.
